Material inventory

Looped surfaces and belt edges: wider, multi-strand wool in green and black

Locking medium: cotton string in black

Lining: black cotton fabric

Ear: wooden, black Bottom: reinforced



You can also use a larger canvas, eg size #3,75. This will make the bag a little bigger.
