

Autumn is coming, and so is the season of knitted dresses. I also bought one of these. The dress has a beautiful pattern on it, as if made for looping. I'll admit that when I saw them in the store on a hanger, I had a very clear idea of how the new handbag would look like. And since it's a knitted dress, I chose a slightly furry chenille yarn as the looping material, instead of fabric stripes and of course in the color combination of the dress itself.

I like wooden handles, but in this case I chose metal ears for the first time to match the metal buttons on the dress.

Dimensions: 26 • 23 cm Depth: approx. 7.5 cm

Material inventory Looped surfaces and edges: chenille yarn Locking medium: chenille yarn Lining: cotton fabric in the color of the yarn Handle: metal semi-circle in the color of rose gold Bottom: reinforced





TIPS FOR IMPROVEMENT

You can place metal rings in the bend in the side parts and attach a chain to the bag for carrying over the shoulder. Or, before you start hemming the upper edge on the back part, you can crochet an arbitrarily wide closure of the purse, which will be closed with decorative buttons already sewn on after being turned over to the front.
