Material inventory Looped surfaces and belt edges: heather and blue wool Locking medium: cotton string Lining: blue cotton canvas matching the color of the wool Handle: wooden, in natural color Bottom: reinforced





TIPS FOR YOU

Notice the different looping direction of the lower part. Compared to the body of the bag, it is looped perpendicular to the blue surface, and thus the bag looks more plastic. The bottom is looped with a spiral technique.
